- Near crossing of Swamp Creek on Craigs Trk (two records)
- Near Honeysuckle Creek Trk, between Upper Boho Rd and Honeysuckle Creek (two records)
- East side of Lima East Rd, about 1.5 km north of junction with Moonee Moonee Creek Trk (two records)
- **Private Land** close to Moonee Creek, near end of Moonee Moonee Creek Trk (one record)
- West side of Ferraris Road, between Harpers No 3 and Harpers No 4 Trks (one record)

- Eastern side of Police Track, north of Rocky Ned (four records)

Lifeform: Small shrub

Location of record: About 1 km east of Mt Barranhet, east side of Seven Creeks.
